

MIRI AFRICA LIMITED – OPEN DATA POLICY

Effective Date: February 21, 2026

This Open Data Policy (the “Policy”) covers users’ choice to publish key weather, air-quality, and soil parameter data (collectively, the “Data”) generated by their use of Miri Air and how such data will be shared and managed once designated as Open Data via Miri Africa’s Site.

For purposes of this Policy, the Platform refers to the integrated Miri Africa system, including the Miri Air device, Site, dashboards, APIs, related services, tools, and technical documentation, through which users access, view, and manage their data, all developed and maintained by Miri Africa Limited (“Miri”, “Miri Africa”, “We”, “Us”, or “Our”), a company duly registered under the laws of the Federal Republic of Nigeria. The Platform generates, collects, stores, monitors, processes and provides structured access to key weather, air-quality, and soil parameter data.

Miri Africa collects Data through the Platform. By voluntarily designating Your Data as Open Data, you consent that Miri Africa reserves the right to make Your Data publicly available under an open license, allowing anyone to access, download, and reuse it in accordance with the terms of that license. You (“You” or “User”) acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to comply with the terms, conditions, and limitations set forth in this Policy. If you do not agree with this Policy, you must not designate your Data as Open Data or otherwise share it through the Platform.

1. GENERAL TERMS

1.1 This Policy establishes the principles and procedures governing the voluntary Open Data and the mechanisms by which such data may be shared, accessed, and reused by the public, and the legal framework, rights, and obligations of both Miri Africa and users in relation to Open Data. It applies to all Data collected from the Platform within the Federal Republic of Nigeria and any other jurisdictions in which Miri Africa operates. The collection, publication, and processing of Data shall be conducted in full compliance with applicable local laws and regulatory requirements in each jurisdiction.

1.2 Open Data Contributions may include:

- (i) Aggregated or anonymized environmental measurement data (including but not limited to particulate matter, gas concentrations, meteorological parameters, and soil metrics);
- (ii) Device location data at the municipal or regional level only, with precise geocoordinates obfuscated to protect operational security and privacy;
- (iii) Temporal metadata necessary for scientific validity and reproducibility.

- 1.3 Miri Africa may make the Data publicly available on third-party platforms, including OpenAQ Platform, under an open license that permits access, download, and reuse in accordance with the terms specified by Miri Africa.

2. USAGE AND CONTROL OF DATA

- 2.1 Miri Africa retains the right to control and use all Data collected through the Platform. Users shall have the right to use the Data generated or obtained from their own use of the Platform for non-commercial purposes only. When users voluntarily designate the Data as Open Data, Miri Africa has the authority to make that Data publicly accessible under an open license, thereby enabling use, download, and redistribution by the public in accordance with the terms of that license.
- 2.2 Miri Africa may transmit eligible datasets to public repositories, including the OpenAQ Platform. Once transmitted, such Data becomes subject to the governance, terms of use, and access policies of the receiving platform, and Miri Africa does not control, monitor, or restrict downstream access, redistribution, or derivative use by third parties.
- 2.3 You acknowledge that, once published, Miri Africa cannot guarantee the complete retraction of Data that has already been accessed, downloaded, or otherwise copied by third parties.
- 2.4 Miri Africa reserves the right to expand or limit the categories of Data made available; reclassify datasets between open, research, or restricted tiers; modify access methods or technical delivery mechanisms; and suspend publication of specific datasets where required for legal, operational, security, or commercial reasons.
- 2.5 You represent and warrant that:
 - a. you possess the necessary authority and all rights, consents and permissions from any end users, device owners, or data subjects howsoever described to share the Data with third party including submitting the Data to Miri Africa and designating such Data as Open Data for publication by Miri Africa, and that such submission does not violate any applicable law, contract, or third-party rights;
 - b. The Data does not contain personally identifiable information, trade secrets, or confidential business information of any third party;
 - c. Sharing the Data does not violate any contractual obligation, statute, or regulation, including the Nigeria Data Protection Act 2023 and any applicable international data transfer restrictions;
 - d. You will implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure Data anonymization prior to contribution.

2.6 You may withdraw Your designation of Open Data at any time and upon withdrawal Miri Africa will cease future publication; however, You acknowledge that copies of Data already accessed or downloaded by third parties may persist and cannot be fully retracted.
